Week 1 - Sunday

Triumphal Entry
Jesus weeps over Jerusalem

Week 2 - Monday

Jesus cleanses the temple for the second time
Jesus meets with Greeks
Jesus speaks openly with them of his death / glorification

Week 3 - Tuesday

the withered fig tree; teaching on faith
Jesus' authority questioned by the religious leaders
Jesus answers his opponents
Jesus' discourse on the Mount of Olives
Jesus speaks of his return

Week 4 – Wednesday

no specific Gospel events appear to be attributed to Wednesday, though there is still debate; even so, we can ascertain some events which were ongoing)
preparations are being made for the Last Supper
Judas and the Sanhedrin prepare Jesus' arrest
Jesus spends the day and night in Bethany

Week 5 – Thursday

Peter and John complete their feast preparations
Jesus celebrates the “Last Supper” with his followers
Jesus reassures the Eleven in anticipation of his arrest
Jesus prays in the Garden of Gethsemane
Judas hands Jesus over to the authorities
Jesus is taken to the High Priest's house
preparations begin for the late-night / early morning trials
